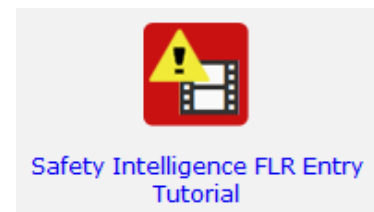

Patient Safety Net to become Safety Intelligence

As we begin working towards the anticipated launch date of May 25, 2016 for Safety Intelligence, we want to ensure everyone has an opportunity to become familiar with this new upgraded platform for event reporting.

All hospital staff and physicians can view an introductory video “Safety Intelligence FLR Entry Tutorial” by logging into the UH Portal. Once logged in, open “my apps”, using the icon found in the upper right part of the page.

The tutorial is accessed by clicking the app button:



The video will introduce you to the new “look and feel” of entering adverse events into Safety Intelligence. For those of you that have used the current PSN system, you should find this familiar.
