Patient Safety Net to become Safety Intelligence

The Patient Safety Net (PSN) system will be upgraded and replaced with Safety Intelligence (SI) over the next few months. The current system administrators are already working with Vizient (formerly UHC) staff to accomplish background tasks for the conversion. University Hospital IST staff have also worked hard to complete their part of the conversion, which will include a link to the ADT system. This will make entering adverse events easier for staff.

This enhanced system will allow for more comprehensive reporting and provides University Hospital with the flexibility to make the questions asked for event reporting more in-line with our needs. Vizient will be providing training for all current PSN Managers throughout May. Dates and times for these sessions will be provided. There will also be sessions for hospital staff to see the new Front Line Reporting interface just prior to the launch.

Information regarding the transition from PSN to SI will be updated and available throughout the next several weeks. Please look for information related to training dates, locations, and times in future publications of Patient Safety News.
